Ajo Transportation picked as rural small business of the year

The Pima County Small Business Commission has selected Ajo Transportation and Casa de los Niños Thrift Store to receive its 2013 Small Business of the Year Awards. Awards are made in two categories this year, rural and urban.

Ajo Transportation, 1248 N. Second Ave., was the rural small business winner. Casa de los Niños Thrift Store in Tucson was the urban small business winner. Each is receiving a \$500 prize.

The awards are an annual program of the Pima County Small Business Commission and is sponsored by District 3 Supervisor Sharon Bronson and the Pima County Economic Development and Tourism Department.

Ajo Transportation was started in 2003 and is owned and operated by Ajo native Cathy Hutton. The company employs 19 people and has a fleet of 12 buses and a bus maintenance facility. It provides 32,000 Dial-A-Ride, curb-to-curb rides in Ajo every year. It also provides 15,500 rides a year on its five daily round trips between Ajo and Tucson and more than 16,000 rides a year on its five daily round trips between Ajo and Gila Bend and between Gila Bend and Buckeye, Avondale, Goodyear and Phoenix. It also provides transportation scholarships to graduates of the GED program in Ajo who go to college or vocational school.

Casa de los Niños Thrift Store was started in 1974 by volunteers to support Casa de los Niños crisis nursery. It is dedicated to workforce development, providing job training and full-time employment to more than 19 people.

"Both award winners showed us their value as small businesses," said Ken Goodman, chairman

of the Pima County Small Business Commission and president of Environmental Strategies Inc. "They know how to take care of their clients and they've gone out of their way to help people in need."

Gabrielle David of Ajo, who sits on the commission, echoed the chairman's sentiments, noting she was very pleased that an Ajo business was the rural recipient. "Andrew Sisk's Oasis Café was the other Ajo nominee and made a strong showing when the votes were counted," said David.

Goodman said the commission received very positive feedback about the winners from both their employees and the people whose lives they've touched. He also said the commission received a record 14 nominations this year.

The Small Business of the Year Award was presented to the Microbusiness Advancement Center in 2010; to Gasoline Alley, an automobile repair and restoration business in Green Valley, in 2011; and to the Joint Technical Education District in 2012.

The Pima County Small Business Commission is comprised of eleven small business owners or managers who represent the business community throughout Pima County. The SBC facilitates communication between Pima County and small business, and evaluates the impact of County policies and regulations on small business.

Consider AUSD dress code when shopping for school clothes

Principal Brian MacKenzie asks that families consider the Ajo Unified School District dress code as they shop for school clothes.

"Every year, we have a few people get upset because they've blown their back-to-school budget on clothes their kids can't wear to school because they don't meet the dress code," MacKenzie said. "We wanted to get the word out early this year to save them the trouble."

MacKenzie said the dress code has not changed much since last year. "We did a little fine tuning for clarification in light of some unfortunate recent fashion trends, like holey jeans, tights as outerwear, and, among a few elementary kids, anti-academic T-shirt logos. When a kid shows up wearing a T-shirt that says 'I'm too pretty to do homework,' that really contradicts the vision and mission of this school."

On the whole, dress code compliance has improved markedly in recent years, MacKenzie noted, especially among boys. "We've come a long way. Boys are pulling up their pants and wearing them like men. We feel strongly that kids should dress like they're going to school, not prison."

The 2013-14 AUSD dress code policy is reproduced below:

Dress Code for Students, Employees and Volunteers

Every student, employee and volunteer shall choose attire that is safe, conducive to their work in the school, and creates no potential distractions for others.

Examples of inappropriate clothing include...

1. Any garment or accessory that poses a safety hazard to self or others.
2. Any garment or accessory that displays text or images regarding alcohol, tobacco or drugs, gang affiliation, weaponry, anti-academic sentiments and/or inappropriate language/sexuality.
3. Hats, hoods, bandanas or any other headwear indoors.
4. Off-the-shoulder tops, halter and tube tops, spaghetti straps, tank tops, sleeveless tops, low necklines that reveal cleavage, tops without full back coverage, unbuttoned shirts, crop tops or any garment that exposes the midriff or undergarments.
5. Transparent clothing or garments with holes anywhere between the collarbone and knees, including mesh fabric, lace, frayed jeans, etc.
6. Skirts, shorts or dresses shorter than the wearer's fingertips with shoulders squared and arms hanging at sides.
7. Pants, shorts or skirts worn below the hipline (e.g., sagging pants).
8. Excessively tight clothing (e.g., leggings/tights/yoga pants/Spandex/Spandex as outerwear).
9. Pajamas or sleepwear.
10. Bare feet, bedroom slippers.

Individuals wearing inappropriate clothing shall be referred to the principal's office for appropriate discipline.

Rain arrival eases fire restrictions on southern Arizona public lands

As of last Friday, July 19, fire restrictions were lifted in most parts of southeastern Arizona. Due to widespread precipitation across the area, additional rain in the weather forecast, and a rise in fuel moistures, it has been determined that the likelihood of wildfire has lessened to the degree that the restrictions can be rescinded.

These areas include Organ Pipe Cactus National Monument, all districts of the Coronado National Forest, Saguaro National Park, Coronado National Memorial, Chiricahua National Monument, Fort Bowie National Historic Site, Tumacácori National Historical Park, and the Arizona State Forestry Division.

Visitors to these and other areas are reminded to always practice fire safety.

Fire conditions as well as localized closures and restrictions are subject to change. Because tribal, federal, state, and local mandates are different, they may have some differences in their year-round regulations and restriction notices.

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The solar project at the Cabeza Prieta National Wildlife Refuge maintenance yard is now operational and staff members and volunteers Sid Slone, Jose Valenzuela, Kim Veverka, Linda Devore, Stephen Howard, and Amanda Selnick held an informal ceremony beneath the roof-mounted array last week to mark the event. Nine modules of 4 photovoltaic panels each produce 7200 watts of electric power to provide electricity for the refuge maintenance shop and area. Howard engineered the system and he and Cabeza law enforcement ranger Donny Ebann installed it.

"Personnel vacancies in the past freed up enough funds for us to acquire the solar array," said refuge manager Slone. Explaining the several year delay between the installation and the system going operational, Slone said it was a combination of getting permits finalized and putting new assistant refuge manager Mary Kralovec on the project. Kralovec noted that she worked closely with Amtek Electric in Yuma and Arizona Public Service as well as fellow Cabeza staff members to push the project to completion.

Letter to the editor Voting is difficult

Editor:
I wonder how many Ajo voters realize that during the last hour of the last Arizona legislative session a bill was passed that will radically change the way elections are conducted in Arizona by making voting more difficult and taking away choices from the voter? As citizens we have the power to make this decision for ourselves and take it out of the hands of self-interested politicians.

Most of us believe that we have a civic duty to vote and elections should be free, fair and accessible, but under HB 2305 voting would become a crime if neighbors picked up signed and sealed ballots for voters on the permanent early voting list.

HB 2305 reduces voter choice by changing signature requirements on nominating petitions which makes it extremely difficult, if not impossible for a Libertarian or third party candidate to qualify for the ballot.

It was said that this bill will reduce voter fraud, but most voter fraud cases in Arizona are the result of winter visitors voting in two different states! This bill does not address that issue.

If enough valid signatures are filed by September 12th, the law does not go into effect, but rather is placed on the next general election ballot in November 2014.

I am part of a statewide effort comprised of many different groups who have come together to protect the most precious of our freedoms: the right to vote.

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) proposes to replace an existing radio repeater co-located with Fish and Wildlife Service communications equipment on Buck Peak with updated land mobile radio (LMR) tactical communications (TacCom) equipment and to install up to two new repeaters at Granite Mountain and Christmas Pass. All three sites are located in designated wilderness within the Cabeza Prieta National Wildlife Refuge (CPNWR). The CBP, at CPNWR's request, has designed sufficient capacity in their systems proposed at Buck Peak and Christmas Pass to allow for the installation and operation of CPNWR equipment.

The purpose of the action is to improve radio coverage where there are currently extensive areas of non-coverage on the Refuge. This will enhance safety for field personnel and improve efficiencies and effectiveness of border security operations.

The Refuge Improvement Act requires an affirmative finding by the refuge manager of the compatibility of an activity before it is allowed on a national wildlife refuge. A "compatible use" is one "that will not materially interfere with or detract from the fulfillment of the mission of the Refuge System or the purpose of the refuge". "The exterior is pretty much done," said Robert Vaughn, manager of Pima County Natural Resources Parks & Recreation's Ajo operations. The county owns the gymnasium. "There were major structural issues caused by a lot of water and termite damage over the years. The building was actually sinking and we had to stabilize the structure," he said. After tearing out rotted framing and degraded material, work crews put in new steel and wood framework. The project has cost roughly \$200,000, said Vaughn, and there's still more to do. But the stabilization is a major accomplishment. Vaughn also cited Durazo Construction, the general contractor on the project, for the excellence of its work.

After more than 40 years of printing small town southern Arizona newspapers, the Toops family of Pueblo Publishers is closing their Glendale printing plant. They've printed newspapers for Gila Bend, Buckeye as well the *Ajo Copper News*. Pictured above are Bill Toops Sr, Darlene Toops, Ed Lopez, Roger Toops and Bill Toops Jr.

"We've had our paper printed at Pueblo Publishers since the early 70s," said *Ajo Copper News* publisher H.J. "Hop" David. "When the mine shut down in the mid-eighties, they carried us, gambling that Ajo's economy would rebound and we'd resume paying our bills on time. They helped us stay in business. The Toops family have treated us very well over the decades." Editor Gabrielle David worked for Pueblo Publishers as a receptionist and in ad sales for about a year in the seventies.

Pressman Ed Lopez, who is retiring, has an Ajo connection. He lived here until his family moved in the early sixties when Ed was about eight years old. His parents were Oscar & Nellie Lopez. Lopez says he still has relatives in Ajo among the Zozaya, Cano and Martinez families. He started working for Pueblo Publishers when he was a teenager.

"Ed Lopez, Billy and Roger Toops, my brother Joe, and I are all about the same age," said Hop David. "I remember my dad taking Joe and me to the printing plant when we were teenagers. The offset press was being operated by three kids our age – Ed, Roger and Billy. They did in two hours what took my dad and three staff members a full day to do using the old hot lead technology, manual collating, and folding. Being kids from the same time, we'd talk about a lot of stuff we had in common -- Wallace & Ladmo, Batman & Robin, radio station KDKB, models sold at Western Auto (funny cars, WWII planes and ships, monsters like Wolfman and Frankenstein). I'm sad to see this era come to an end."

County seeks input on bond priorities

Pima County's bond program, with voters' support, has made possible such things as library and parks expansions and developments. At the same time, according to the county in a recent press release, through the capital improvement program, some 14,500 jobs countywide have been sustained, as well as the stimulation of local economies with critical capital.

Because continued needs warrant consideration of another bond issue, Pima County would like its citizens' assistance in identifying the investments that are of the greatest importance throughout the region. After consulting local jurisdictions and community organizations, more requests came in than the county can fund in a future bond election. Narrowing down the list for a potential future election, notes the release, will be extremely difficult.

The county has developed an online survey that will be available through Friday, August 2, and will allow it to gather more information as it begins the process of winnowing down community requests.

The survey lists proposals submitted to date to the Pima County Bond Advisory Committee, divided into five primary areas:

- Historic, cultural and natural area conservation;
- Public health, flood control, neighborhood reinvestment and governmental facilities;
- Libraries, museums and community facilities;
- Job growth, education and workforce training; and,
- Parks and recreation.

The survey asks respondents to identify the projects felt to be most needed. The survey will take about 10 minutes to complete, depending on how the respondent answers the questions. The survey may only be taken once.

1. Name. The name of the Corporation is Community Partners, Inc.

2. Character of Affairs; Purposes.

A. The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes. The Corporation shall be operated exclusively for such purposes.

B. The Corporation shall act in the general public interest for the public good;

C. The Corporation may engage in any lawful activities, none of which is for profit, for which corporations may be organized under the corporate laws of the State of Arizona; and

D. C. Notwithstanding the above, no distributions under this Article shall be made if the making of such distributions would result in the Corporation failing to maintain its qualification as an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

D. In the event that after application of Paragraphs A and B, above, there are assets of the Corporation remaining to be distributed, such assets shall be distributed, such assets shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
