School busy with trips, testing, and new teaching staff

Career-oriented field trips are being planned for Ajo High School students to expose them to daily life at Organ Pipe Cactus National Monument and at the US Border Patrol Ajo Station.

Ajo Unified School District principal Dr. Lauren Carriere, who gave a report at the recent meeting of the Western Pima County Community Council, said the students will be able to ask questions and interface with National Park Service employees and USBP agents to help them see if they might like to pursue a career with one of the government organizations. Carriere added that the Park Service is observing its 100th anniversary with free transportation and park entry for all fourth-grade students, paid for by grants from the National Park Foundation.

In other school news, Carriere said the number of students enrolled at AUSD has increased this year to 451. Last year's student body was 427. The increase may be attributed to some new families moving into town and some students who were formerly home-schooled, noted Carriere.

A new teacher from Jamaica, Desha Dennis, has recently started at AUSD. Carriere said there are now two teachers at the school from Jamaica, two from India, and several from the Philippines. She said one additional new teacher, Evriel Kelly, who arrived this week, is from the small island of San Andrés – part of Columbia – located off the coast of Nicaragua.

A round of MAP, or Measures of Academic Progress, testing began recently at AUSD. Tests are held three times each year with a final test in May, according to Carriere.

The new marquee in front of the school will be streaming information soon. Carriere said electricity is being run to the sign

and office staff are learning how to remotely control the messages.

Representatives from Freeport-McMoRan are meeting with teachers to discuss how they can apply for grants and tap into other available resources, such as an on-line mining virtual tour.

Six AUSD teachers have received from \$1,000 to \$2,000 each from an organization called DonorsChoose.org, which allows potential donors from around the country to scroll through lists of projects and choose one or more they wish to fund. Each of the teachers has a project specific to his or her class, and funds will be used for items such as video production equipment, a 30-foot by 50-foot National Geographic map that will be displayed in the school gym, and a mobile plant station.

The recent evening in the school garden was discussed. Carriere said she and the rest of the AUSD administration are "thrilled with all that's going on at the school and we want to keep it going!"

Sheltering Ajo art opening is Friday

The Sheltering Ajo homelessness assistance committee is holding an art opening, silent auction, and shirt sale in the Art Under the Arches gallery in the Plaza on Friday, January 29, from 5:30 to 8 p.m. The opening will feature artist Jon Linton and his "I Have a Name" project to raise awareness and resources to end homelessness in Ajo.

Linton's project will include photographic portraits of homeless individuals in Arizona, a presentation about the project, and an interactive discussion led by a Sheltering Ajo representative. The goal of the project is to bring dignity and humanity to those less fortunate, noted organizer Morgana Wallace Cooper. Since its creation in 2007 the project has seen several exhibitions and regional forums on homelessness. It reaps tangible rewards by feeding and clothing homeless individuals.

Linton said he took an interest in Ajo because of how different homelessness looks in an isolated rural environment with people sleeping in washes or couch-hopping until the welcome is worn. Homelessness may be the result of a domestic violence issue, joblessness, or generational drug use. Sometimes, people passing through Ajo get stuck — for example by having their car impounded — and are temporarily homeless because of the distance from available services.

"Many residents are unaware of the problem of homelessness in Ajo because it is almost invisible here," said Wallace Cooper. "There are no homeless shelters in Ajo. Sheltering Ajo provides temporary shelter and care based largely on the support of the community. Please come to our fundraiser to learn more about this serious issue, and bring a non-perishable food, hygiene, or clothing item to donate to the homeless in our community."

Three vets to be honored at VFW

The local American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars posts will honor three local citizens for military service to their country on Sunday, January 31, at 2 p.m. in the VFW Hall.

The three to be recognized are Navy veteran Richard Malcom, Army veteran Gabriel Jacobs, and Air Force veteran Michael Silva. Each will receive a plaque honoring service to country.

"This has been a tradition that the veteran clubs in Ajo have been doing for several years now," said Legion committee chair Bryan Blow. "It started with Walter Richardson, who was in the Army and won the Silver Star, two Bronze Stars, and 2 Purple Hearts, and was dying of cancer. We hope that many people come and show their respect to these men who wear the uniform and put their lives on the line in service to our country."

A potluck will follow the ceremony. Blow said bringing a dish to share is encouraged but certainly not mandatory.

William Arthur Eaker, 86, of Why, died in Scottsdale on January 5, 2016.

Mrs. Hensley and her family attended the First Baptist Church and she worked at Sears in Ajo for many years.

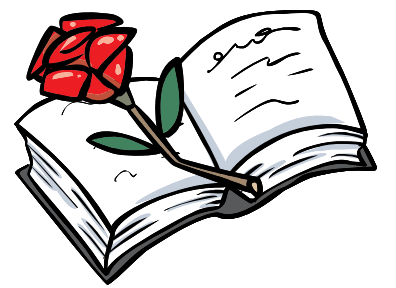
They moved to Green River, Wyoming in 1977 after Phelps Dodge layoffs, residing there for 14 years. She worked briefly for Sears there and then worked in the

Garden club will meet on Monday

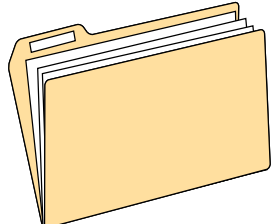
The Ajo Garden Club will hold their monthly meeting next Monday, February 1, at 10 a.m. at the library.

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Gradillas retired from constable position



George Gradillas has been something of an Ajo icon since moving to the area from Tucson with his family in 1992. Along with his exploits serving the community first as a probation officer and later as constable, many also remember him affectionately as the junior high girls' softball coach or from the numerous other coaching jobs he held over the years.

Gradillas officially retired on the last day of 2015. He began the constable job in 2006, replacing Bob Harral who had retired at that time. Serving 4-year elected terms, Gradillas was a year into his third term when he decided it was time to spend more time with family, especially the grandkids.

Constables have been an important part of Arizona's justice system since before statehood, according to the pamphlet *Arizona Constables*. The names Wyatt and Virgil Earp stand out as famous Tombstone lawmen who served as constables.

The primary function of a constable now is to serve paperwork generated by the justice courts, noted Gradillas. That may include a summons, an order of protection, injunctions against harassment, subpoenas to appear in court, writs of restitution (eviction notices), writs of execution (property seizures), writs of garnishment, and arrest warrants.

"A constable mostly serves civil papers, and only occasionally criminal papers," said Gradillas. "But generally, if someone sees me coming to their door, they pretty much assume they're not going to have a good day."

Other duties include serving as a bailiff and attending justice court within a precinct to enforce civil or criminal court orders arising out of court actions. An example Gradillas cited was of a criminal DUI suspect who was given a field release by deputies. A constable would then serve the defendant papers to inform him or her of an upcoming court date in the case.

"When I'm serving papers, I never know the details of the case, and I generally don't find out the results, either," he said. "I always made sure I was respectful and, if the situation arose, I would patiently hear the person out or let them vent or explain their side of

the story. I showed respect to everyone I was in contact with, and I hope people saw me that way. I never demeaned anyone."

Gradillas said that was undoubtedly a factor in his unbroken string of peaceful serves. He noted that there is some inherent danger in the position, and constables throughout the land have been assaulted, stabbed, even shot while serving papers. The potential may be higher in larger urban areas but some rural areas may also see barricaded defendants, hostages, and their usually bad outcomes, noted Gradillas.

"So even though I had always had a good outcome, I still needed to be on guard on every service, because you can never be sure what you are getting into," he said. "Serving eviction notices was always very difficult because it so heavily impacts a person or family."

Training to become a constable involves on-the-job learning as well as attending formal classes. Gradillas said he attended four-day sessions twice a year for firearms skills, self-defense techniques, conflict resolution, public communications, and on the many scenarios of serving papers.

Serving from Ajo to Lukeville, the only special gear Gradillas wore was a Kevlar vest and a radio to communicate with deputies. He said he typically served papers alone, but if it was learned a resident being served might have weapons, a deputy would go along.

Gradillas retired a first time in 2004 after 33 years of service as a juvenile probation officer, the last 12 of them in Ajo. Prior to that he worked as a detention officer in juvenile court in Tucson, from 1972 to 1977. From 1968 to 1972 he served as an administration sergeant in the Air Force, stationed at Lackland AFB in Texas, Dover AFB in Delaware, Korea, and Luke AFB. He was graduated from Salpointe Catholic High School in Tucson in 1968.

He met his wife Gloria in 1982 as she worked as an intake specialist at juvenile court in Tucson. They were married in 1984. Daughter Rosemary was born in 1988 and Roxanne in 1990. Rosemary is raising a family in Tucson with her husband, and Roxanne is pursuing her career in

Phoenix.

George & Gloria have always been busy in the community. George has served on the Ajo Cemetery board and as a school athletic coach for multiple sports. He is still an active member of the ISDA board and the Desert Senita health center board. Gloria served as a Girl Scout troop leader along with Stella Peterson for many years. Future plans include continued volunteer work with various organizations and an eventual move back to Tucson.

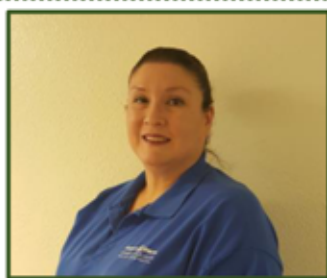

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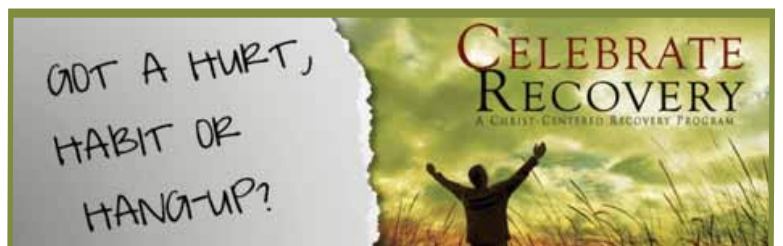

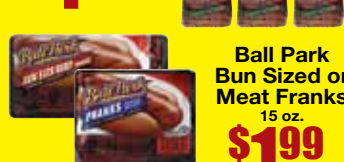
