According to Raymond Spitzer, "Choir members cheered the new songs, but additional choir members are needed. In recent years the choir has been dwindling. Annual DSCHC scarecrow contest protected plants like saguaros nearing end

An unusual lack of crows the Desert Senita around Community Health Center may be the result of the skilled work of health center employees who this month constructed scarecrows as a part of a traditional health center competition. Health center patients will choose which one they like best to win the yearly contest.

Departments of the health center formed teams and built their straw-stuffed sentinels that, in years past, have been a part of the Fun Family Fall Festival organized by DSCHC each October.

This year, with the larger outdoor entrance space created during the health-center's recently completed multimillion-dollar remodel, the scarecrows are being displayed for a longer time.

The winner of the best-traditional-scarecrow competition will be chosen on Halloween by a vote of visitors to the health center between now and then.

Potential voters receiving care at DSCHC can vote for their favorite scarecrow in the new lobby area with the entrance, now completed, on the west side of the health center at any time before the winner is chosen.



With the relocation and/or destruction of saguaro and other columnar cacti within the 60-foot wide Roosevelt reservation taking place to make way for construction of the Trump administration's border wall, some may believe that the salvage, sale, or relocation of such cacti is something they can legally do. The truth is not as simple.

The Army Corps of Engineers has been told they have the latitude to ignore dozens of environmental and other laws to speed the construction of border barriers. A section of legislation attached to the 2005 federal Real ID act has been interpreted by the Department of Homeland Security to mean that laws don't apply if they impede border wall construction.

Section 102 of the Real ID act, so named because of its primary focus on changes to driver's licenses and other forms of federally recognized identification, includes the following language "...the Secretary of Homeland Security shall have the authority to waive all legal requirements such Secretary, in such Secretary's sole discretion, determines necessary to ensure expeditious construction of the barriers and roads under this section."

The DHS interpretation was challenged in court, but recently US District Judge Ketanji Brown Jackson ruled against the challenge making the waivers lawful unless challenged in the US

Supreme Court.

Permits are still required to move

But laws relating to digging up a saguaro, or other protected plant still apply to everyone else.

An Arizona law relates particularly to saguaro cacti, specifically the Arizona Revised Statute 3-906, entitled Collection and Salvage of Protected Plants. It says that anyone "who moves or salvages a saguaro cactus (Carnegiea gigantea) that is more than four feet tall, from other than its original growing location, must purchase a permit, tag and seal from the department." That department is the Arizona Department of Agriculture.

Other native plants have protections of their own.

Small property owners do have an exemption from prosecution under the law however. In the A.R.S. 3-904-H, it states that the rule "does not apply to the destruction of protected native plants on individually owned residential property of ten acres or less where initial construction has already occurred."

Selling protected plants from a homeowner's property still requires a permit, but not destroying them if the property is under ten acres.

Moving or destroying protected plants on any public lands always requires prior permission from the

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Floyd S. Lacewell

Floyd Sylvester Lacewell Jr., 75, died at his home in Ajo on September 30, 2019.

He was born in Columbia, South Carolina, on July 21, 1944, to Mary Nell (Player) and Floyd S. Lacewell Sr.

After high school, he served in the Air Force from 1961 to 1970, seeing service in Vietnam from 1969 to 1970.

He married Catherine Kissinger on December 1, 1975, at the courthouse in Ajo.

He started his US Customs career in 1971 as a detector dog officer in San Luis, Arizona. He became a Customs inspector in 1973 and a Customs patrol officer in 1974. He transferred to Lukeville in 1974 and advanced to branch chief of the Lukeville Customs Patrol Office.

In 1983 he transferred to the US Customs Air Branch in New Orleans. In 1986, he transferred to Memphis, Tennessee, as a US Customs special agent/criminal investigator.

In January 1987, he transferred back to Arizona to the US Customs Air Branch in Tucson. Later that year, he transferred to Ajo as the resident agent in charge of the Lukeville/Ajo/Sells Customs Office of Investigations. He retired from that position in 1994 and made Ajo his permanent home.

In 2002, he came out of retirement for four years working as a security guard at the auxiliary air base in Gila Bend.

Mr. Lacewell's remaining years in Ajo were spent honing his woodworking skills, following his favorite Arizona sports teams, and enjoying small town life. He also Douglass Funeral Home.




The parade is part of a long tradition. Local historian Louie Walters gave the Ajo Copper News some background on the event.

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Shoppers, sellers, and onlookers assembled in the Plaza on Saturday morning for the first in a weekly series of Plaza Artisans Bazaar events.

Plaza Artisans Bazaar debuted

Artists and artisans who, in years past, have sold locally-produced goods at weekly farmers markets alongside local food growers, have formed a new organization. The result is a new weekly event called the Plaza Artisans Bazaar that debuted Saturday and will continue on Saturday mornings from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. in front of the Art Under the Arches and Space In Time art galleries in the Plaza.

Artisan baker Sylvia Howard said the move to create a separate event from the farmers market was to preserve a presence in the Plaza.

The Ajo Farmers Market is moving this year to a space just west of the new Farmers Market and Café on 100 Estrella, near the Plaza.

The move puts the booths closer to the brick and mortar location and to a commercial kitchen where food can be prepared.

But Howard said there is still a need for an event like the bazaar located in the Plaza, taking advantage of a good location and stimulating shopping at other plaza businesses.

The split means Ajo residents and visitors will get to partake of multiple outdoor markets during the week. The Ajo Farmers Market operates Thursday afternoons and Saturday mornings. The new Plaza Artisans' Bazaar is also on Saturday mornings, with a short walk between the two.

E-commerce will be topic of workshop on Sunday

A workshop to teach local artisans how to use the internet to generate sales will be held this Sunday, November 3, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. in the Cholla Room at the Sonoran Desert Inn & Conference Center. The workshop is free but those planning to attend must register beforehand by calling or texting Leba London at 520-354-7111 or e-mailing ladyfromajo@gmail.com. Basic computer and internet skills are a prerequisite.

"Two years ago, Tony Ford delivered a 7-week e-commerce seminar in Ajo that participants are still raving about!" said Tracy Taft. Ford, the CEO of Magnitude Management, an international business development and media agency, and a TEDx speaker and comic, will be joined in leading the workshop by Vannessa "V" Ford, chief marketing officer of Magnitude Management and owner of Thimble House and Etheria Dolls.



Students and professors from the University of Arizona took pictures of the murals in the Plaza's Artists Alley last Sunday during a trip to Ajo to study anthropological and journalistic aspects of US border issues.

UA group visited Ajo studying border issues

Drs. Celeste González de Bustamante, University of Arizona journalism professor and Linda Green, UA anthropology professor brought four of their students to Ajo on Sunday for students to meet with members of No More Deaths and Samaritans. The four students, Sascha Fruehauf, Audry Herran, Amiee Rodriguez, and David Thalenberg, are studying the anthropology of migration and how to ethically report on US-Mexico borderlands.

A project for some of the students is a pair of podcasts they are producing, including one that will focus on the humanitarian work and ensuing court trials of Ajo resident Dr. Scott Warren.

In June, a jury deadlocked voting 8-4 not guilty on three charges stemming from a day in early 2018 when Warren provided access to food, water, clean clothes, and shelter to two men who were found to be undocumented migrants. The trial galvanized local, national, and international attention on Warren and humanitarian aid work on the southern border.

Federal prosecutors dropped conspiracy charges as a result of the mistrial, but have decided to retry Warren for charges of illegal harboring. That trial begins next month

Part of the podcast project of the UA students visiting last weekend will focus on what effect Warren's trial and retrial could have on future humanitarian aid

No More Deaths volunteer and Ajo resident Maria Singleton led students and professors to points of interest around town during their visit Sunday. The tour included a visit to The Barn, where volunteers have a staging area for desert aid efforts. It was at The Barn that Warren was arrested in 2018. The group also visited the Ajo Samaritans Aid Station, and the murals of the Artists Alley at the south end of the Plaza.

The group met Tom Kiefer, who talked about his work as a photographer and his exhibition in Los Angeles titled, El Sueño

Skirball cultural center opened on October 17. It showcases a selection of over one hundred photographs from Kiefer's ongoing project photographically depicting personal objects such as toothbrushes and rosary beads taken from migrants during processing after they were apprehended crossing the desert near Ajo. The exhibition also includes

Americano: The American Dream.

Kiefer's exhibition at LA's


interviews with Kiefer and with migrants who have themselves crossed the border. That exhibition will continue in LA through March.
