Students' safety in Ajo is primary

Long before Friday's devastating elementary school shooting in the upscale community of Newtown, Connecticut, the subject of a secure environment has been on the radar of Superintendent Robert Dooley, and on the agenda of the Ajo Unified School District board.

Asked about the most recent school shooting, Dooley expressed his personal grief, adding "The Ajo school district has, and has had, a safety action plan in place for several years. I have communicated with principal Brian MacKenzie, and our school psychologist this weekend regarding this incident. We have also communicated with all staff to help ensure that existing safety procedures are followed."

Dooley said that those procedures include lockdown plans, and the means to assure communications in case of an emergency event. Dooley added that the size and layout of the AUSD campus is challenging, but that "we are always looking at ways to best protect our students and faculty. All high school classroom doors have been locked during class time since August 2012. We are now telling all teachers to lock their classrooms during class time."

Dooley noted that in the past, a school safety officer had been assigned to the school through the Pima County Sheriff's Department, but that the program had been suspended due to county budget cuts. "I have reached out to Lt. B.J. Clements this weekend to see if we can review the situation," said Dooley.

CNN reported Sunday that Sandy Hook Elementary School, site of the shooting that took 26 lives, including 20 children between the ages of six and seven, had well-rehearsed security procedures in place, from regular lockdown drills and student and teacher practices, to required photo IDs for visitors, security cameras, and a closed campus that locked its front doors after 9:30 a.m. Teaching students and teachers what to do is critical, noted the CNN report. "Students need to know to trust those in charge," said Bill Bond, safety school specialist for the National Association of Secondary School Principals.

Arrangements are being made to assist students who have questions and fears surrounding the issue, said Dooley. "We will be addressing school safety more thoroughly again, after the holiday recess. Our students' safety is our primary concern at Ajo School," Dooley said, "and students who feel safe, learn better."

Adopt a lot of love for just a little

Pima Animal Care Center has kicked off a December bid to make sure more shelter animals have a better chance at finding a home this holiday season.

Most adoption fees are just \$25. Adoptions include updated vaccinations, a microchip and spay/neuter surgery. Adult dogs will require an additional \$15 licensing fee.

"During the holidays, there are so many families who are willing to open up their hearts and their homes to pets," said Justin Gallick of PACC in Tucson. "We really hope they will consider adopting from shelters, since we have so many worthy, adoring pets to pick from. They can get a lifetime of love for \$25."

Some pets are available at the Ajo shelter for even less. Animals who have been there long-term may be adopted for just \$10.

Since pets should never be surprise presents, Pima Animal Care Center also offers gift certificates, so that friends and loved ones can pick out the right pet for their households when the time is right for them.

The Ajo shelter is open Monday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.; Wednesday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.; and Friday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. For more information call 387-7502.

Ajo Christmas Eve traditions are long-standing

The Christmas Eve celebration in Ajo is a tradition with roots as far back as 1916. Here are excerpts from accounts published in the *Ajo Copper News* from years past.

1946

"I must tell you how they celebrate Christmas in Ajo...You would have to see it to believe it; we have never seen anything like it!

"There was a huge pine tree on the platform in the middle of a beautiful park which is bordered by tall palm trees, life size murals, music, and shirt sleeve weather.

"About 6:30 there were people everywhere. They tell me that some of the Indians had come as far as 75 miles by horse and wagon so that their children could see the program. Kids off to college came home, and people who had moved away from Ajo came back just to see Ajo's Christmas tree. Up by the school there was another large crowd waiting for Santa to make his usual unique appearance...Suddenly there was a loud bang somewhere which sounded like a giant firecracker; ... and Santa Claus came sailing right down out of the sky...In a few seconds, as if by magic, bright colored lights came on and there in the middle of a most beautiful sleigh pulled by four well groomed reindeer stood old Santa Claus, waving...Shrill cries of "Hello Santa," filled the air.

I don't see how things could have been much grander."

1962

"Even today, (from *Ajo Copper News* 1962) we are isolated from other towns, but in 1916 there were no railroads, busses, automobiles running into our town; just wagon trails. And Christmas was especially bleak for youngsters.

"It was through Dr. Eckert that the Elks of Silver City put on the first Christmas tree celebration in Ajo in 1916. This was the beginning of a tradition that has lasted through all these years.

"Mrs. Hans Nelson was called upon to help get this community celebration together. (Her husband, Hans, was assistant mill superintendent for many years)...Dr. Eckert told her if she would get the women together to do the work he would get everything down here from Silver City. There were no stores yet, but you just never know about the ingenuity of our pioneer women.

"The candy was all in bulk and there was fruit and nuts to be put into individual packages. Mrs. Nelson called the ladies together at her tent and they went to work. She just happened to have some cheesecloth on hand, but of all things, it only came in one shade — white — and they needed red. No one had any red dye but Mrs. Nelson had some red tissue paper and they used that to dye the cheesecloth. She also had some strong silver cord and they used that to tie the socks. Only two ladies had sewing machines so they sewed while others snipped and they soon finished forty stockings. Actually, they had more than that because some of the kids went through the line more than once.

"That trouble has always been with us. The ladies were wondering how they could keep the youngsters from going through the line more than once and one of the women spoke up. She said that she knew all the kids in town so she would be stationed at the beginning of the line and she would know who had been through. When they were all finished going through, there were some stockings left and the lady who knew all the children noticed a boy standing close by and she asked if he wouldn't like a stocking. He said, "Thank you just the same but I have already been through the line five times."

Dr. Eckert had gotten two beautiful Christmas trees from Silver City for this wonderful occasion, but there was no electricity in Ajo and candles wouldn't do so well outside, even if you happened to have them....They asked Michael Curley if they might borrow all the lanterns. They could — so they hung six of them on a rope between the two Christmas trees and scattered the others among the branches of the trees. I don't suppose any other tree has ever meant so much or been quite as grand as that first one.

" In 1917 Ajo had electricity and so began the tree that we have today and the men and businesses of Ajo were asked to contribute.


"Our children's children come back to Ajo each year at Christmas time to take part in this fantasy. For it is truly that, if you have ever watched Santa come out of the dome of the Curley School and enter his sleigh at the foot of the stairs and begin his ride down, around the plaza with literally thousands of old and young following close behind.

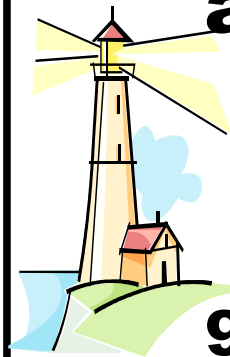

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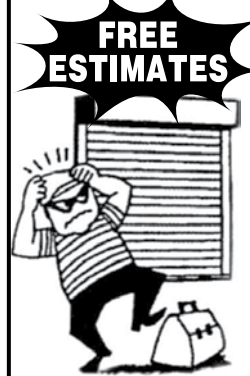

LEO's focus is community enrichment

The concept of bringing area youth and others together with residents lacking the physical or financial means to accomplish basic work projects has been brewing in the minds of several local business people for some time. The concept took shape recently with the establishment of the LEO store just south of the Chu Chu Club on North Second Avenue. LEO stands for Life Enrichment Organization.

The non-profit was born in Ajo in 1991 when Ray Lockwood filed the necessary paperwork. LEO director Rick Shumway explained that the vision is ready to move forward to help the eligible elderly and disadvantaged families with basic work projects around the home. Three core programs are being offered.

House-to-Homes primarily involves the painting of the exterior of a residence. Shumway emphasized that the program is for homes in need of repair, not for developers of commercial properties.

"It's a win-win for everybody," said Shumway. "The homeowner gets a newer, cleaner environment to live in while motorists and others passing by benefit from an enhanced view. LEO hopes the community will embrace the concept and see the benefit of it in a short amount of time."

Between 15 and 20 homes are being scheduled for enhancement from March to May, according to Shumway. He said House-to-Homes will be an annual effort every spring for the foreseeable future. He noted that the spring months have agreeable temperatures for outdoor work such as painting, and many winter residents are still here.

Volunteers are being sought for work projects through public awareness as finished projects become visible, noted Shumway. He said acceptance of the LEO programs has been "resounding" from visitors to the store.

Project White Dove focuses on painting and resurfacing grave markers in the cemetery.

Project Boomerang seeks to couple youth with senior citizens for after-school or summer employment in basic yard care,

planting a tree, or odd jobs around a house. Shumway said a contract would be worked out between the client and the worker and his or her parents concerning pay and hours.

"All I do at LEO is introduce the two sides and exchange phone numbers," he said. "Of course, youth who perform well will no doubt be recommended for other projects. It's another win-win because kids learn basic work skills as they gain an understanding of the needs of many of the elderly, and the seniors get projects completed."

A side effort of LEO involves the sale of affordable adult undergarments.

The store displays painting supplies in one section and gently used furniture and appliances in the main section. Shumway said more home repair items and tools for purchase will be displayed in the near future.

In getting ready for a game, Glass says a prayer and then meditates trying to get his mind in tune with his body. He quotes the well-known truth: "The mind is the most important muscle."

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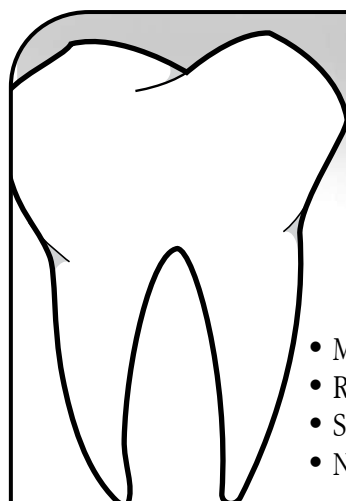

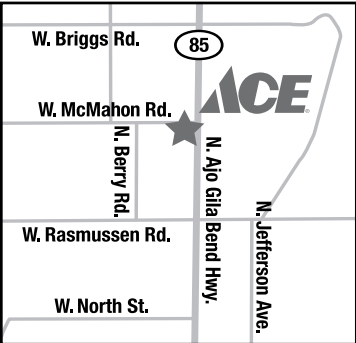
